Test Format

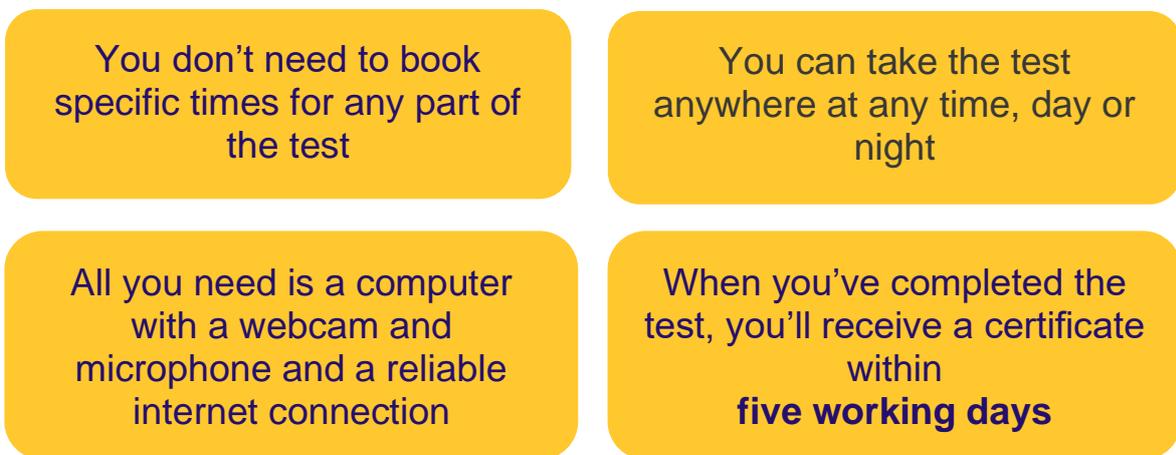
The test is administered in one sitting. It can be taken at any time. You do not need to book any sections separately.

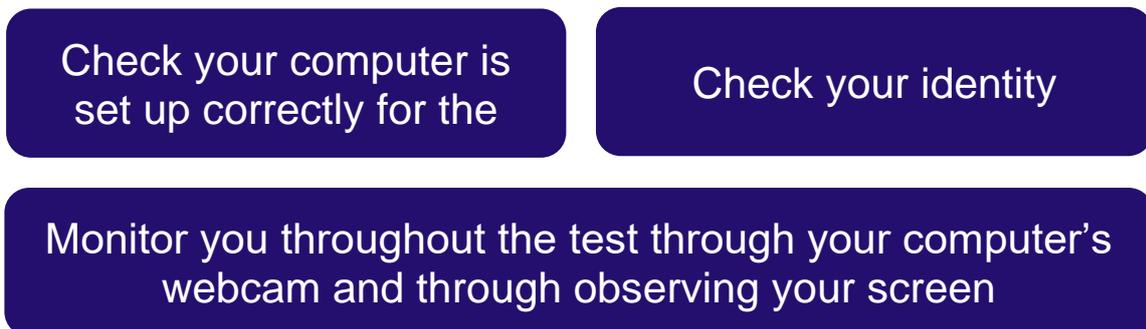

Frequently Asked Questions

What should I do if I have an issue during my test?

You can contact the Kaplan International Tools for English Team at englishtest@kaplan.com if you have any problems. You'll receive a response within 24 hours (working days only). Proctortrack also has an online helpdesk, which will help you if you have problems with the remote proctoring service.

How can I prepare for the test?

As the test is an English proficiency test, there is no specific learning material to study. Any learning resources which improves your English will help you prepare.

We will provide a practice test to give you a feel for the test and an opportunity to practice.

Make sure you have all the necessary equipment ready and that your internet is reliable and fast enough. We'll let you know the technical requirements before you pay for the test, so you can check your computer and internet are ready.

What equipment do I need?

You will need a webcam and a microphone. These can be separate or in-built (part of your computer). You may also want to use headphones/earphones to make the listening section clearer.

How is my test graded?

The reading and listening sections are graded automatically by the testing platform.

The speaking and writing sections are graded by a human grader, according to these criteria:

- Speaking: Overall Response, Linguistic Range and Accuracy, Fluency
- Writing: Overall Response, Linguistic Range and Accuracy, Coherence and Cohesion

How many times can I take the test?

There is no limit to the number of times you can take the test or how soon after a previous attempt. Please bear in mind, however, that you are unlikely to make big improvements to your score unless you study more English between attempts.

Do all universities accept the Kaplan International Tools for English test?

Not all universities accept Kaplan International Tools for English certificates. If you're applying for a particular university, you should contact them to check.

Does the certificate expire?

There is no expiry date on the certificate. However, the date of your assessment is recorded, so a university may not accept a certificate which is too old.

What kind of Photo ID is accepted?

Any official ID with a photo and your name is accepted such as a passport, national identity card or driving licence.
